CELEBRATING 109 YEARS

February 1903: Walter Alexander Hill and E.A. McCallum form Hill & Company. The fledgling enterprise engaged in real estate and the general insurance business.

1909: Western Surety officially opened its doors as the Saskatchewan Guaranty & Fidelity Co.

1949: After the Saskatchewan Government bought 100% of Saskatchewan Guaranty & Fidelity Co. shares, The Hill Family established Western Surety.

1977: The Hill Companies purchase CKCK-TV, the Regina-based CTV affiliate station. Harvard Broadcasting is established.

1981: Harvard expands into radio with the purchase of CKRM-AM and CFMQ FM now CHMX-FX (My 92.1 FM) in Regina SK.

1982: Harvard Energy is established through a partnership with the Hill family and a private investor.

1982: Harvard Investments Inc. is established.

1983: 620 CKRM becomes the voice of the Saskatchewan Rough Riders.

1994: Harvard Developments and partners form UFR Urban Forest Recyclers.

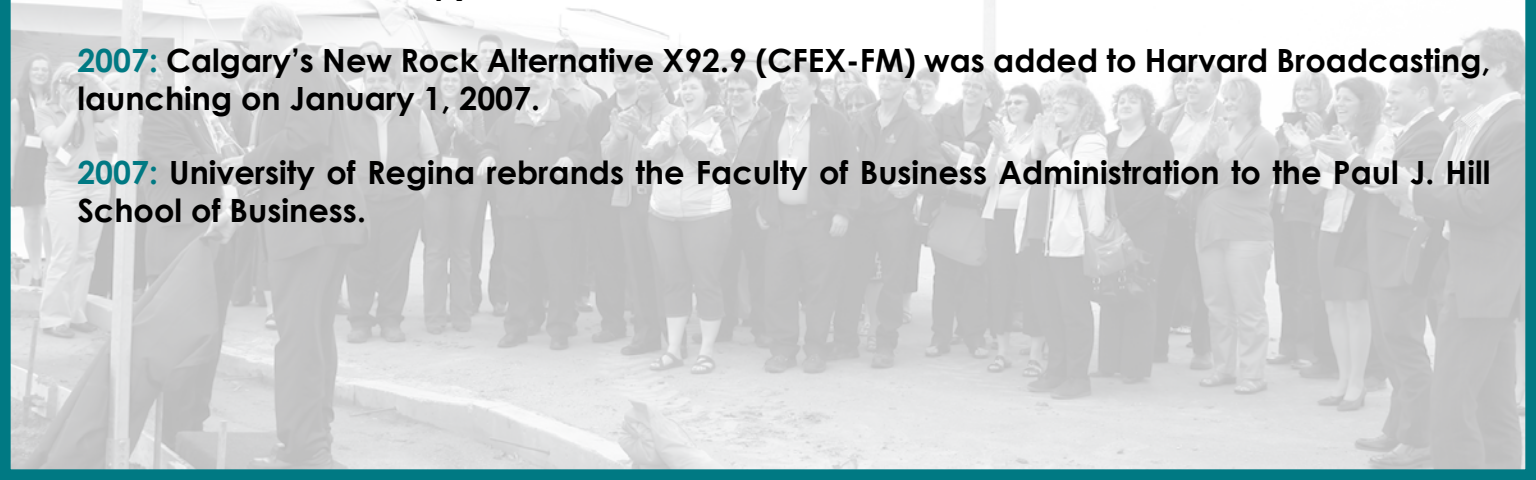
1996: Cooks McCallum Hill Insurance is formed (merger between McCallum Hill Insurance and Cooks Insurance).

2002: Harvard Broadcasting acquired Regina's Rock Station 104.9 The Wolf (CFWF-FM).

2005: Cooks ISI Insurance is formed (merger between Harvard Developments Inc. and Western Financial Group)

2007: Calgary's New Rock Alternative X92.9 (CFEX-FM) was added to Harvard Broadcasting, launching on January 1, 2007.

2007: University of Regina rebrands the Faculty of Business Administration to the Paul J. Hill School of Business.

2008: Fort McMurray's Mix 103.7 Today's Best Music (CFVR-FM) opened its doors on January, 2008.

2008: Cooks ISI Insurance purchases Shenher Insurance.

2008: On August 25, 2008 an official ground breaking ceremony is held for one of Harvard's legacy projects, Currents of Windermere.

2009: On April 9, 2009 Harvard Broadcasting opened Wired 96.3 FM (CFWD-FM), Saskatoon's New Music Channel.

2009: September 1, 2009 Yorkton's GX94 (That's Country – CJGX-AM) and The FOX (The Best Mix – CFGW-FM) joined the Harvard Broadcasting family.

2009: Harvard Western Insurance is founded.

2010: Harvard Broadcasting launches 100.7 FM The River, a mainstream Adult Contemporary station located in Red Deer on August 3, 2010

2010: Harvard Broadcasting launches 95.7 FM The Sound (CKEA-FM) on Monday, September 6, 2010, a 90's gold- based Triple A (Adult Album Alternative) station.

2010: June 18, 2011 Harvard Developments Inc. breaks ground at Grasslands. Regina's first master planned retail development comprised of 1,000,000 square feet of retail space.

2011: On September 6, 2011 Paul J. Hill with project partners Regina Catholic Schools, Campion College, Jesuits in English Canada, and NativityMiguel open the Mother Teresa Middle School of Regina.

2011: On March 25, 2011 Harvard Broadcasting rebrands Edmonton's 95.7 FM The Sound to LITE 95.7 FM, Edmonton's LITE favourites.

2011: On August 3, 2011 Regina's LITE 92 FM is rebranded to My 92.1 FM, Feel Good Now.

2011: Harvard Broadcasting has acquires Hot 107FM Edmonton
